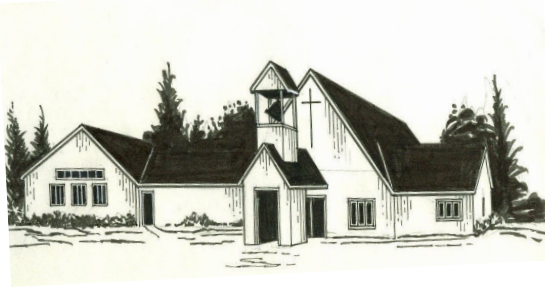

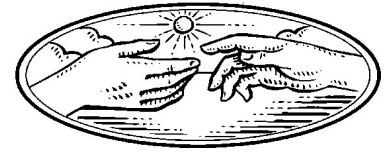

October 14 - Heart of the North Day of Renewal

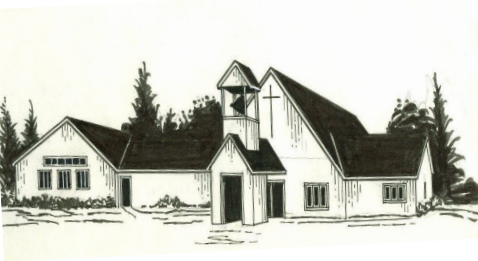

### ADRC MEALS ON WHEELS AT LAKESIDE

Sebrina Naglosky spoke to the council on changes in the way ADRC is handling Meals on Wheels and congregate in-person dining. They are moving from 3 kitchens to 1 in Siren. This development caused the A&H Senior Center to decide not to participate and a new dining area was needed. They will prepare the food in Siren and bring it to Lakeside in bulk to be packaged for home distribution and in-person dining. They will use our plates, silverware, etc., for those using our facility. About 7 or less attend on **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday**. They will need the kitchen and a portion of the fellowship hall between 9:30 and 12:30 and

will clean up after themselves. Should a funeral or some other function conflict, they will make other arrangements.

#### Cost and Details:

Meals will be served around 11:00am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. If you wish to make a reservation, or cancel a reservation, please call 715-349-2154, 24 hours in advance. Menu is subject to change without notice. Bread and milk offered with all meals.

60 Years of Age and Older: \$4-\$6/meal donation.

General Public: \$10 /meal
