2023 has been another successful year for quilting.

We have been blessed with many new faces on Tuesdays helping us complete our quilts. On Saturday, October 14, 2023, we took VanPykeren's trailer full of our boxes down to Rice Lake Ingathering (tractor trailer). We delivered our 250 quilts and 8 dress kits which will be taken to the distribution center. When we pulled in with the trailer they wanted to know if we had collected from other churches or was this all ours. Proudly we said they were all ours and answered how we process our quilts.



Hopefully we inspired other church groups!

The September Mission of the month was for the shipping of these quilts. We collected \$435, plus Jolyne obtained a Thrivent grant of \$250. World Relief requests \$2.25/quilt and \$1 for each dress kit towards the shipping. We were able to send the whole amount of \$570.50.

With the remaining amount we purchased more batting and supplies.

Thank you once again for all your support of this mission. We help so many around the world with this mission and have fun accomplishing it.

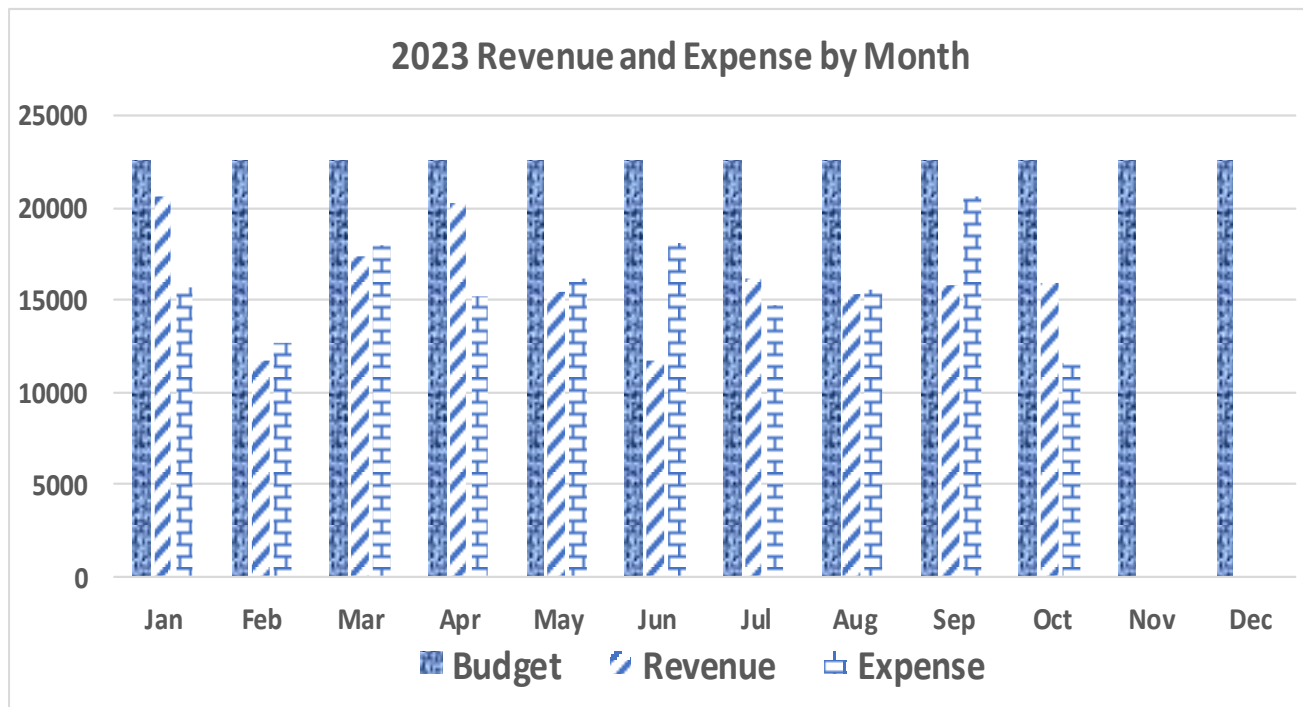
