



The Lakeside Community Lutheran Church financial activity for April 30, 2024 is as follows:

Thank you for the financial support of our ongoing ministry as we continue the call process for a new pastor.

Although we are currently funding our budgeted operations by using rotating temporary Pastors, our current level of monthly receipts have fallen over the past several months and will not support the "Call" of a full-time Pastor.

To fund a full time Pastor monthly giving will need to increase approximately 40%. To fund a full-time Pastor in mid-career our giving will need to increase to at least \$19,000 per month.

At our current giving level, we would only be able to sustain a "one-half time" Pastor in mid-career. There-in lies our challenge.
