



Thank you for the financial support of our ongoing ministry as we continue the call process for a new pastor.

Although we are currently funding our budgeted operations at a reduced level by using rotating temporary Pastors, our current level of monthly receipts have fallen over the past several months and will not support the "Call" of a full-time Pastor.

After the June 11, 2024 congregation council meeting, an information sharing and "listening" session was held to engage the congregation. Seventeen members participated with comments, suggestions and idea sharing centered on increasing membership, attendance on Sundays and the Sunday offering.

GATHER BIBLE STUDY "After Certainty" focuses on what it means to live in faith after certainty. In these years of a worldwide pandemic, escalating climate change, political turmoil and a changing religious landscape, it may feel like the days of probability and stability are behind us. What will the future bring?

July's study will focus on Community. When certainty in faith becomes the responsibility of the individual, this can isolate us from God and from community. The reformer Martin Luther's own failures of certainty led him to return to passages in the gospels and epistles that proclaimed salvation, not as a reward for our certainty, but as a gift granted in and through community. In this second session, we consider how some of the pivotal texts of the Lutheran Reformation changed the church and the world.

July 8th – July 12th





returned to the mobile library as well. If you would like to use the service but do not visit the ADRC meal sites, patrons can request the Library material they want, and they can be delivered with your meals.


While you are at the mobile library, why not sign up for the lunch and enjoy a meal with some old friends or new friends?
