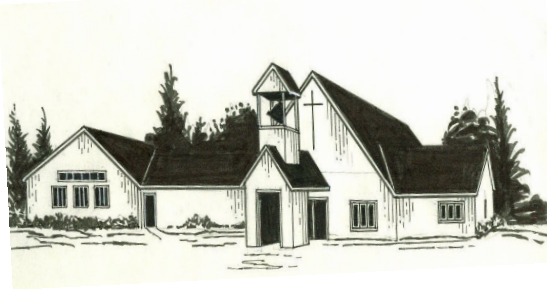

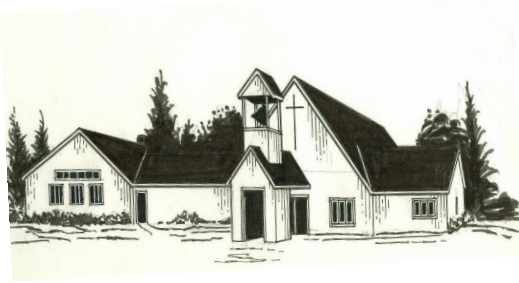

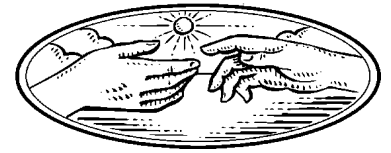

Thank you for the financial support of our ongoing ministry as we continue the call process for a new pastor. Although we are currently funding our budgeted operations at a reduced level by using rotating temporary Pastors, our current level of monthly receipts have fallen over the past several months and will not support the "Call" of a full-time Pastor.

A stewardship committee has been formed to renew our 'commitment to generosity'. The month of August is dedicated to highlighting our varied activities and ministry programs, and gathering the various committee requests for funding in the 2025 budget.
