



Thank you for the financial support of our ongoing ministry as we continue the call process for a new pastor. As you read this message, we will have completed the special congregational meeting to act on the "call" of pastor Peter Johnson.

We finished the year of financial operations at a reduced level by using rotating temporary "guest pastors" and reduced office hours as we currently do not have any scheduled office hours for pastoral access. With this reduced level of operations we were able to "save" \$60,452. The council has set aside \$30,000 of this savings to provide financial assistance for the 2025 budget as we call a new pastor. We are close to a financial break even point for 2025 with our current level of giving, and with the \$30,000 set aside, the financial outlook for 2025 will allow us to confidently "call" a one-half time "part-time" pastor.

The 2025 adopted annual budget equates to a monthly average of \$14,800. This budget level provides for our current rotation of "guest pastors" and our Administrative Interim Pastor. The budget amendment passed along with the "call" of pastor Johnson at the special congregational meeting increases the monthly average to \$18,100. The increase provides for the terms of a part time pastoral candidate starting on April 1st. The monthly average will need to increase in 2026 to \$19,500 to cover a full year of the part-time pastoral model of operation.

Pray for the best outcome possible coming soon!!
