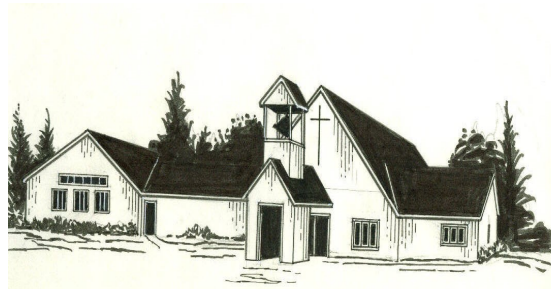

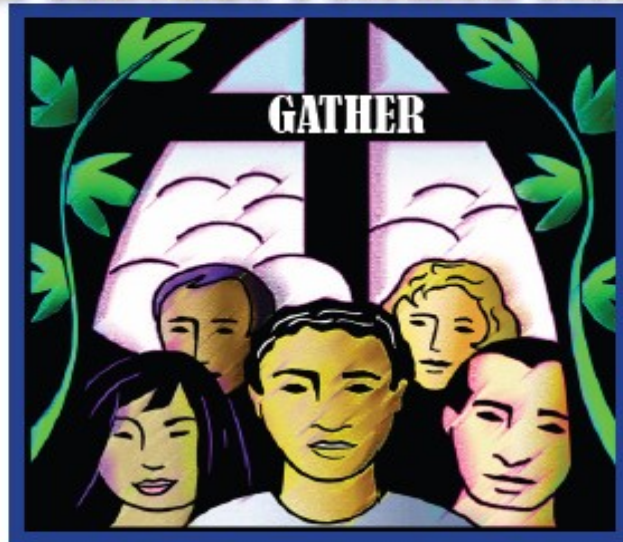

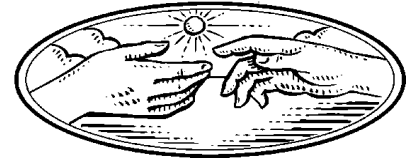

August 30, 8:00 am – 2:00 pm The Annual Bake & Craft Sale

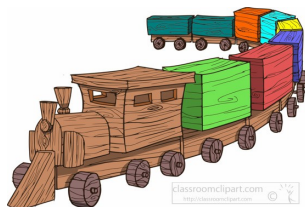
8:00 until gone: coffee, rolls & muffins

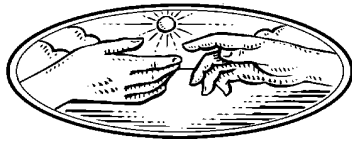

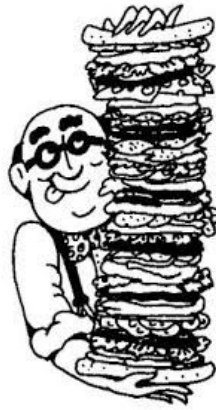
Moving Day August 1st
